

**Antiques and Collectibles Tour**  
***The Philippi-Buckhannon Area is rich in  
Antique and curio shops.***

**Tour begins at *Covered Bridge Bed and Breakfast* in Philippi  
or the *Adaland Mansion***

**First Stop- Covered Bridge Bed and Breakfast**

This restored Victorian home features quality antiques throughout the house. The dining room set as well as two bedroom suites are original to the house. The home is listed on the National Register of Historic Places as the Peck-Crim-Chesser house. It was completed in 1883 and owned by descendents of that family until 1995. The house is celebrating its 125<sup>th</sup> birthday this year. Antiques of the Victorian period are featured in the decoration of the house.

**Second Stop- Adaland Mansion at Philippi**

From the Covered Bridge B and B travel through the Covered Bridge and turn right on US 119. Proceed 3 miles to the junction of 119 and WV 76. Turn left for one mile and turn right on the Adaland road.

Construction at Adaland began in 1868 with the mansion house completed in 1872 by Augustus Modisett. The house was built from materials available on the land and is Neo-Greek in design. The antiques on display are from the period from 1860 to 1920 and were donations to the restoration by local families and persons. Antiques from the Empire and Regency period are early antiques in the house. A collection of Rococo Revival 1850-1880 and Renaissance Revival 1850-1880 are found in the house as well as Eastlake late 1870-1890's. The antiques can be viewed as a part of the guided historic tour available for \$5.00 each.

**Third Stop- Buckhannon Antique Mall, Rt. 20 South**

Returning to Philippi, proceed on US 119 South for approx. 10 miles to the junction of US 119 and WV 20. Turn left on WV 20 South for about 8 miles to the Buckhannon Antique Mall. The mall is located on the right hand side of the road and is reached by a driveway with parking lot. The phone number is 304-472-9605. If you pass Lowe's you have gone too far.

**Fourth Stop- Main Street Buckhannon, WV**

Leaving the Antique Mall turn right onto WV 20 and proceed to the city limits of Buckhannon. Go to the third stop light and turn left onto Main Street. Park on Main Street where you can shop the three antique stores, stroll through specialty shops, bookstores and quaint restaurants. . Main Street Antiques and Collectibles (304-473-1101) has 14,000 sq. feet of antiques, collectibles and a vintage wine section. The Buckhannon Emporium Antiques and Collectibles at 37 W Main Street (304-472-5560) has 30+ dealers.
