

Driving Tour from Snowshoe Resort to Adaland via Beverly Tour

Bus Tour begins by leaving Snowshoe

First Stop – Beverly – Walking Tour

Restroom – Stay for about 1 hour

Leave Snowshoe and travel down Snowshoe Rd for 5.2 miles. Turn right onto WV 66 for .7 miles. Turn right onto US 219 to Huttonsville (25.6 miles). At Huttonsville, turn left onto US 219/US 250 for 11.6 miles to Beverly. Stop at Beverly for walking tour of *Historic Beverly*

Second Stop – Adaland Mansion

Restrooms \$ – stay about 1 hours

Continue to travel N on US 250 through Elkins, to the intersection of US 250/US 33/WV 92. Turn right onto US 250/WV 92 to Philippi. Turn right onto US 119 for 3 miles then turn left onto WV 76 to Adaland Mansion. *Adaland Mansion*. The antebellum-style brick home, built using emancipated slave labor in 1870, is on the National Register of Historic Places. Lunch and a 40 minute guided historic tour will be given.

Third Stop –Historical Philippi

\$ – Stay for about _ hour

Leave Adaland and turn left onto WV 76 to US 119. Turn right onto US 119 for 3 miles to the Blue and Gray Park. Tour the Covered Bridge and Barbour County Historical Museum – home of the “Philippi Mummies”.

Final Stop – Snowshoe

Leave the Blue and Gray park by turning left onto US 119 South for .25 miles and turn left onto US 250 to Elkins (23 miles). Stay straight on US 250/US 219. At Huttonsville, turn right onto US 219 to WV 66. Turn left onto Snowshoe RD.

Leave Snowshoe at 9:30am and return at 5:30 pm
