

Bus Tour from Stonewall Resort at Roanoke, WV to Adaland

Bus Tour Begins by leaving Stonewall Resort

First Stop – Buckhannon for shopping

Bus Parking – Handicap restrooms – stay about 1 hour

Leave Stonewall Resort and travel north on US 19 for 3.5 miles, merge onto I-79 north towards Clarksburg. Exit at exit 99 and veer to the right on US 33 E for 13 miles. Exit WV 20 – Downtown Buckhannon. Shop downtown Buckhannon. Various gift shops, bookstore, antique shops and many others.

Second Stop – Adaland Mansion

Handicap Restrooms – Bus parking – Lunch - \$\$ - stay about 2 hours

Leave Buckhannon on WV 20 for 7 miles to US 119. Turn right onto US 119 for 16 miles to WV 76. Turn right onto US 119 for 3 miles to WV 76. Turn left onto WV 76 for 1 mile to ***Adaland Mansion***. The antebellum-style brick home, built using emancipated slave labor in 1870, is on the National Register of Historic Places. Lunch and a 40 minute guided tour will be given.

Third Stop – Historical Philippi

Bus Parking - \$\$ - stay about _ hour.

Leave Adaland and turn left onto WV 76 for 1 mile to US 119. Turn right onto US 119 for 3 miles to the Blue & Gray Park. Tour the Covered Bridge and Barbour County Historical Museum – home of the “Philippi Mummies”

Fourth Stop – Appalachian Glass Factory

Bus Parking – Handicap restrooms – stay about 1 hour

Leave Blue & Gray Park by turning left onto US 119 S for 2 miles and turn right onto WV 57 for 12 miles. Make a slight right turn onto WV 20 for 3.9 miles to I-79. Merge onto I-79 S towards Charleston to exit 99 – Weston exit. Turn left onto US 33 W for 2.5 miles to the CARP Market to Glass Factory. Tour, glass blowing demonstration and gift shop.

Final Stop – Stonewall Resort

Leave Weston via US 33 west to I-79. Merge onto I-79 S towards Charleston to Exit 91. Turn right onto US 19 to resort entrance.

Leave Stonewall Resort 9:30am and return at 5:30pm - Cost for tour \$18.00
